General Duties of a Plumber: Assemble, install, alter, and repair pipelines or pipe systems that carry water, steam, air, or other liquids or gases. May install heating and cooling equipment and mechanical control systems.

RANKING SYSTEM POINTS

Applicants who don't qualify for direct entry will be placed in the RANKED POOL in descending order based on the number of points scored. You can earn points for having a driver's license, completing an approved pre-apprentice program, education related to the occupation, and also for work experience of one year or more.

- To receive points for classes, you must provide course certificates or school transcripts
- To receive points for work history, you must provide documentation of work hours (W-2's, letters from employers on company letterhead stating type of work performed and number of hours worked per year, pay stubs, DD214, or work history print-out from the State of Oregon employment division. (We cannot use resumés for scoring.)

All documentation must be received by the final day of applications are selected
